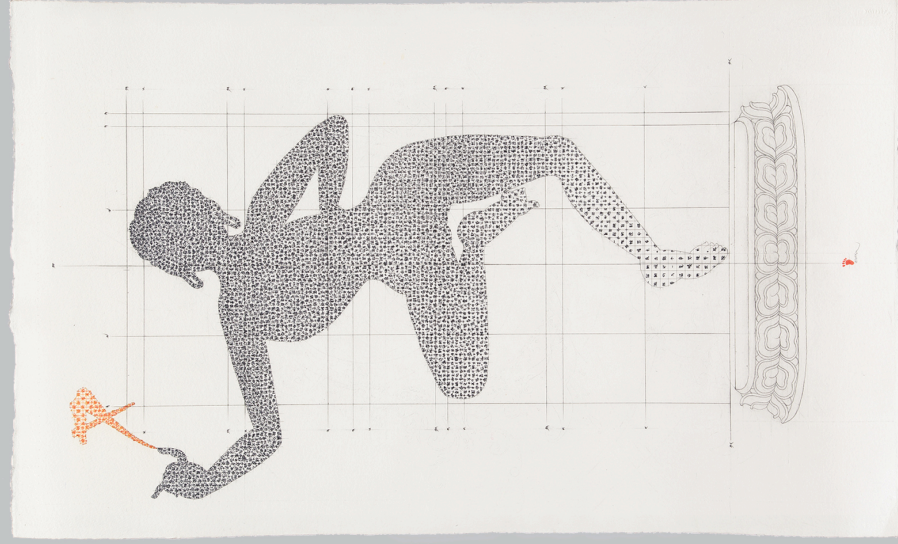


ASIAN ART IN LONDON
